Harper Government Boosts Global Competitiveness of Western Canadian Agricultural Sector

March 16, 2015 - Regina, Saskatchewan - Western Economic Diversification Canada

First-time international buyers travelling to Canada's Farm Progress Show (CFPS) in 2015 and 2016 will be able to access support through the show's Incoming Buyers Program thanks to a federal investment announced today by Tom Lukiwski, Parliamentary Secretary to the Leader of the Government in the House of Commons and Member of Parliament for Regina—Lumsden—Lake Centre, on behalf of the Honourable Michelle Rempel, Minister of State for Western Economic Diversification.

Harper Government support of \$399,750 through the Western Diversification Program (WDP) will pay for half of the travel costs for eligible international buyers, to a maximum of \$1,500 per buyer. Funding will also assist CFPS with the installation of an automated software registration program for more convenient online exhibitor registration, as well as the purchase of a multi-transmitter that will let international visitors attend seminars and show tours in the language of their choice.

This is Western Economic Diversification Canada's third investment in the Incoming Buyers Program at CFPS. The program helps western Canadian agriculture machinery manufacturers create international partnerships and engage in the international agricultural marketplace.

Quick Facts

- With more than 900 exhibitors, the CFPS is Canada's largest agricultural technology tradeshow, and attracts about 700 international buyers.
- More than 45,000 people from over 50 countries visit the CFPS each year to see the latest innovations in agriculture technology and equipment.
- The 2013 show resulted in about \$37 million in new export sales for western Canadian suppliers.
